



CDFI Credit Union Impact

Community Development Financial Institutions (CDFIs) must meet stringent criteria to become certified. CDFI credit unions must:

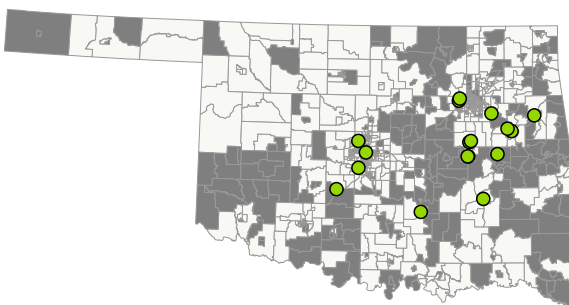
- Direct at least 60% of their lending toward economically distressed people and communities, and
- Build members' capacity to manage credit, increase savings, and increase their financial well-being.

Oklahoma's 5 CDFI Credit Unions:

- Have combined assets of **\$544.3 million**
- Serve **48,104** members through **17** branch locations

Oklahoma's CDFI credit unions achieve impact through **\$366.0 million** in active loans to members, including:

- **\$63.3 million** in community mortgage lending
- **\$264.9 million** in local consumer financing
- **\$17.5 million** in lending to local businesses
- **\$20.4 million** in affordable alternatives to predatory payday loans

- **23.0%** of residents have incomes below the federal poverty line
