2. Local Involvement: Describe involvement with the credit union movement at the local level. This could include support of other credit unions in the community and/or involvement with the credit union chapter. (open field) (1-20)
3. State/Regional Involvement (within the last year): Describe Cornerstone or related organization involvement, including advocacy activities, service on boards, committees and councils. (open field) (1-20)
4. National/International Involvement (within the last year): Describe national involvement, including service on boards and committees. (open field) (1-20)
5. Community Involvement (within the last year): Describe community involvement, including service on boards and committees (i.e., Lion's Club, Chamber of Commerce, Rotary, etc. (open field) (1-10)
6. Describe any Special Honors or Recognition: (open field) (1-10)
7. Contributions: What does the Nominee Support? (click options) Cornerstone Foundation, State PAC, or CMN CU for Kids (up to 5 points)
8. Letter of recommendation (at least one required) (5 points)
